QP12 1427 Canyons dawn chorus early V1 5.0.wav	Dawn chorus with prominent chatter of Violet-green Swallow and calls of Spotted Towhee with faint Western Meadowlark, Common Poorwill, Western Tanager, Rock Wren, Gray Catbird, Great Blue Heron in distant background.
QP12 1428 Canyons dawn chorus early V2 5.0.wav	Early dawn chorus of songbirds with prominent Spotted Towhee, Violet-green Swallow, Black-headed Grosbeak. American Robin joins in background. Very faint low frequency beats in background are drumming of grouse. Faint hollow roar is wind at ridge top resounding. Classic Canyons dawn chorus.
QP12 1429 Canyons dawn chorus 5.0.wav	Dawn chorus of songbirds with prominent Spotted Towhee and chattering Violet-green Swallow in flight. Spotted Towhee flies close at 5:00 lands becomes much louder. Background includes Black-headed Grosbeak, Western Tanager, woodpecker tapping. Background includes American Coot, Mourning Dove, Say's Phoebe, Common Poorwill, Rock Wren.
QP12 1430 Canyons dawn chorus active diverse V1 5.0.wav	Dawn chorus of songbirds is active and diverse with Mourning Dove, Violet-green Swallow, prominent Spotted Towhee, Dusky Flycatcher, prominent Lazuli Bunting, Western Tanager and wing flutters sounds (close at times). Background with Common Poorwill, Western Meadowlark, American Coot, Black-headed Grosbeak. Sensational insect flyby at 4:06. Echoes.
QP12 1431 Canyons dawn chorus active diverse V2 5.0.wav	Dawn chorus active of songbirds is active and diverse with Mourning Dove, Violet-green Swallow, wing flutter close (3:12), Lazuli Bunting, Dusky Flycatcher, Western Tanager, American Robin, woodpecker drumming, Black-headed Grosbeak, echoes of Western Meadowlark distinct. This file naturally follows V1 in species sequence during increasing sunlight.
QP12 1432 Canyons morning birds 5.0.wav	Morning bird activity with prominent American Robin also Spotted Towhee, Violet-green Swallow, Mourning Dove. Background with Western Meadowlark, Red-breasted Nuthatch and prominent rapid wing flaps. Winds beginning with gentle breathes. Peaceful.
QP12 1433 Canyons morning birds later 5.0.wav	Late morning bird activity includes White-throated Swift, Black-billed Magpie with prominent close Spotted Towhee with wing flutters then diversity builds to Western Meadowlark soon featured with clear ringing echo. Delicate details of winged insects tending flowers. Also present are Dusky Flycatcher, Canyon Wren, Red-breasted Nuthatch, Mountain Chickadee, Northern Flicker, Mourning Dove, Nashville Warbler, Western Tanager, Common Raven, American Robin. Far background has Rock Wren, House Finch, Dusky Grouse. Wood drumming. Delicate insect wing hum and Hummingbird wings. Close insect at 8:50.
QP12 1434 Canyons morning late birds diverse 5.0.wav	Diverse late morning bird activity includes prominent House Finch, Red-naped Sapsucker drums followed by loud cry (1:58), woodpecker drum, Spotted Towhee, Red-breasted Nuthatch, Red-winged Blackbird, Black-billed Magpie, Ruffed Grouse drum loud (3:48), California Quail, Dusky Grouse, American Robin, Western Meadowlark. Far background has Wilson's Snipe, Wild Turkey, Ruby-crowned Kinglet, American Coot.
QP12 1435 Canyons morning birds Mourning Dove 5.0.wav	Morning bird activity with prominent Mourning Dove. Large bird flies right to left (1:03). Other birds include Chukar, Dusky Flycatcher, Spotted Towhee, Mountain Chickadee, American Robin, with distant background of Western Meadowlark, Say's Phoebe, Yellow-rumped Warbler, woodpecker drum, House Finch, Dusky Grouse, Canyon Wren, Northern Flicker, Red-breasted Nuthatch. Drone is naturally caused by numerous hummingbird wings.
QP12 1436 Canyons morning birds Mourning Dove coyotes 5.0.wav	Morning bird activity with prominent Mourning Dove and coyote chorus (esp. 1:45) causing Canyon to reverberate. Echoes haunting. Distant bull bellows indistinct. Other birds include Nashville Warbler, Canyon Wren, distinct hummingbird wing sounds (close 4:15), Dusky Flycatcher, Chukar, Chipping Sparrow, House Finch, Western Meadowlark, Brown-headed Cowbird, Say's Phoebe, Clark's Nutcracker. Close bird wing flaps (3:12). Wind soft. Drone is natural from combination of hummingbird wings and echoes.
QP12 1437 Canyons day birds 5.0.wav	Daytime bird activity with Northern Flicker, Violet-green Swallow, Western Meadowlark, prominent White-throated Swift. Also Spotted Towhee, Canyon Wren (featured at 4:20), Say's Phoebe, Mourning Dove, wood pecking and drumming. Winged insects, close at times. Wind sighs faint, blending well with insect wing hum. Rock fragmentation audible(7:28) caused by sun's heat expanding rock surfaces.
QP12 1438 Canyons day birds water hole V1 5.0.wav	Daytime bird activity in vicinity of small water hole begins with loud piercing calls of Red-winged Blackbird with Rock Pigeon cooing from middle ground rock ledge. Also present are Yellow Warbler, wing flaps, wood drumming, coyote and Black-billed Magpie. Use near water source at Canyons during late morning or during calm days.
QP12 1439 Canyons day birds water hole V2 5.0.wav	Daytime bird activity in vicinity of small water hole begins with Red-winged Blackbird with Rock Pigeon cooing from middle ground rock ledge. Distant coyote chorus frequent. Light ridge top wind. This is continuation of V1.
QP12 1440 Canyons day birds V1 5.0.wav	Active morning birds with loud wood drumming of Northern Flicker and calls of Black-billed Magpie. Wing sounds from insects and hummingbirds are common. Also present are Canyon Wren, Chukar, Mourning Dove, Chipping Sparrow, American Robin, Western Meadowlark, Dusky Grouse. Close bird on branch (2:00) continuing. Canyon echoes pronounced. Bull bellows faint (3:08).

Canyon rim wind gently breathes. NR applied.
QP12 1448 Canyons day birds Meadowlark Magpie V2 5.0.wav	Western Meadowlark with clear echoes, Black-billed Magpie also prominent. Mourning Dove, woodpecker drum in background with Spotted Towhee, Dusky Grouse, Vesper Sparrow, Common Raven, Rock Wren in far background. Faint cricket. NR applied.
QP12 1449 Canyons day birds Meadowlark Magpie V3 5.0.wav	Western Meadowlark solo with clear echoes. Black-billed Magpie also prominent. Spotted Towhee, Dusky Grouse, woodpecker drum, Mourning Dove, Western Kingbird, Lazuli Bunting, Rock Wren, Common Raven, Northern Flicker in background. Single cricket. NR applied.
QP12 1450 Canyons day birds Meadowlark Magpie V4 5.0.wav	Western Meadowlark solo with clear echoes. Black-billed Magpie also prominent. Spotted Towhee, Dusky Grouse, frequent woodpecker drumming, Mourning Dove, Western Kingbird, Lazuli Bunting, Rock Wren, Common Raven, Northern Flicker in background. Single cricket. NR applied.
QP12 1451 Canyons day birds Meadowlark Magpie breezy V1 5.0.wav	Day bird activity includes Western Meadowlark (especially close 3:46) and Black-billed Magpie, woodpecker drumming, Spotted Towhee, Mourning Dove, Dusky Grouse, Rock Wren, Common Raven. Single cricket chirps softly in foreground (2:54). Numerous winged insect flyby. Light breeze.
QP12 1452 Canyons day birds Meadowlark Magpie breezy V2 5.0.wav	Day bird activity with Western Meadowlark singing prominently with clear echoes and chatter of Black-billed Magpie. Single cricket intermittent in foreground. Background with Dusky Grouse, woodpecker drum, House Finch, Spotted Towhee, Lazuli Bunting, Western Kingbird, Mourning Dove. Rock Wren in far background. Occasional breathes of ridge top wind. Spacious.
QP12 1453 Canyons evening bird Spotted Towhee crickets faint V1 5.0.wav	Evening bird solo of Spotted Towhee with faint crickets. Use to preserve calm evening mood when temperatures remain warm.
QP12 1454 Canyons evening bird Spotted Towhee crickets faint V2 5.0.wav	Evening bird solo of Spotted Towhee. Background with faint crickets, Field Sparrow, American Goldfinch with faint crickets. Use to preserve calm evening mood while temperatures remain warm.
QP12 1455 Canyons dawn birds wind soft V1 5.0.wav	Early dawn chorus of songbirds with light wind coming from canyon rim. Birds include prominent Spotted Towhee feature with background Violet-green Swallows chirping in flight, joined later by American Robin, Black-headed Grosbeak, Dusky Flycatcher, faint Common Poorwill and Mourning Dove.
QP12 1456 Canyons dawn birds wind soft V2 5.0.wav	Early morning dawn chorus with wind coming from canyon rim consistently. Prominent Violet-green Swallow in flight, Wilson's Snipe, Spotted Towhee, also Killdeer, Common Yellowthroat, Western Tanager, Sora, Pacific-chorus Frog. Deer walks, snorts (3:03) and walks away (4:20).
QP12 1457 Canyons dawn birds Spotted Towhee wind water 5.0.wav	Dawn bird activity with distant flowing water becoming clearer at times due to undulating air layers. Spotted Towhee foreground and Frequent Rufous Hummingbird wing sounds. Background includes Common Raven, American Robin, Black-headed Grosbeak, Song Sparrow, Common Yellowthroat. Deer movement.
QP12 1458 Canyons dawn birds wind arrives 5.0.wav	Dawn chorus of songbirds with prominent American Robin. Background with Dusky Flycatcher, Spotted Towhee, Brown-headed Cowbird, Violet-green Swallow, also Say's Phoebe, Red-breasted Nuthatch. Wings flapping. Wind increasing over time but remaining soft and spacious. Use late dawn as sun's rays first hit canyon rim.
QP12 1459 Canyons dawn birds wind soft wing flutters 5.0.wav	Dawn chorus of birdsong with soft steady wind coming from canyon rim. Includes prominent American Robin with Dusky Flycatcher, Spotted Towhee, Mourning Dove, Western Meadowlark. Wing flaps prominent (1:11) from cold shadows of canyon floor. Also present in background are House Wren, woodpecker drum, Dusky Grouse, Canyon Wren. Close fly in of bird (3:33).
QP12 1460 Canyons dawn birds wind pass leafy 5.0.wav	Dawn chorus of songbirds active with American Robin, House Finch, Mourning Dove, Dusky Flycatcher, Spotted Towhee. Wind building slowly, leaf rustle at times, then subsiding.
QP12 1461 Canyons dawn birds wind leafy 5.0.wav	Dawn chorus of birdsong with American Robin, House Finch, Mourning Dove, Dusky Flycatcher, Spotted Towhee, intermittent breeze leafy.

Birds include Chukar, Black-billed Magpie, Mourning Dove, American Robin, Spotted Towhee, Dusky Grouse, Canyon Wren, Say's Phoebe, Rock Wren, White-crowned Sparrow. Deep low frequency is natural rumble produced as wind passes over and around rock surfaces.
QP12 1464 Canyons morning birds chatty bush wind light 5.0.wav	Mourning Dove coo and American Goldfinch chatter with Common Grackle. Winged insect at times. Wind light. Use for shrubs or small trees near canyon wall during late morning through midday hours.
QP12 1465 Canyons morning birds Mourning Dove wind light 5.0.wav	Morning bird activity with prominent Mourning Dove with light wind tone from canyon rim. Prominent Dusky Flycatcher and Western Tanager. Also present are Mountain Chickadee, Canyon Wren, Chipping Sparrow, American Robin, Spotted Towhee, Nashville Warbler, Red-breasted Nuthatch, Common Raven, Chukar. Faint bull echo at times. Wind soft and variable.
QP12 1466 Canyons morning birds Canyon Wren wind 5.0.wav	Morning bird activity with prominent Canyon Wren and Spotted Towhee. Prominent wing flaps of large birds throughout (especially 2:00). Western Meadowlark, Rock Wren, Chukar, Black-billed Magpie, and Mourning Dove also present.
QP12 1467 Canyons morning birds wind consistent 5.0.wav	Morning bird activity with wind light, consistent. Birds includes Rock Wren, Black-billed Magpie, Western Meadowlark, Bullock's Oriole, Dusky Flycatcher, Chukar, Spotted Towhee, Say's Phoebe. Winged insects produce humming texture.
QP12 1468 Canyons morning birds ruckus wind builds 5.0.wav	Morning bird activity with wind tone from canyon rim. Ruckus-like bird calls and wood drumming repeated calls. Pronounced wing flaps (7:37). Birds include Dusky Flycatcher, Mourning Dove, Dusky Grouse, Spotted Towhee, American Robin, House Wren, hummingbird wings, Western Meadowlark. Wind light variable, slowing building over time.
QP12 1469 Canyons morning birds wind variable 5.0.wav	Morning bird activity including prominent Spotted Towhee with wind light, roaring quietly, then building, blending nicely with Rufous Hummingbird and insect wing sounds. Also present are Common Yellowthroat and Black-headed Grosbeak. Low drone is naturally caused by wind passing over and around rocks in canyon enclosure.
QP12 1470 Canyons morning birds subdued wind strong 5.0.wav	Moderately strong morning winds subdue bird activity. Prominent White-throated Swift chatter becoming louder (2:20) prior to wind gust. Spotted Towhee also prominent at times. Flowing water deep background.
QP12 1471 Canyons day birds Western Meadowlark wind gusts 5.0.wav	Day bird activity feels muted with brief roaring wind gusts. Western Meadowlark prominent and windblown, becoming loud (1:32). Winged insects in flight, sometimes close (4:12, 7:05). Also present are Black-billed Magpie, Vesper Sparrow, Mourning Dove, with faint Rock Wren, American Kestrel, Spotted Towhee. Keep at low volume. Quieting over time.
QP12 1472 Canyons day birds Black-billed Magpie wind roar V1 5.0.wav	Wind roar variable with active Black-billed Magpie. Also present Western Meadowlark, American Robin, Dusky Grouse, Northern Flicker, woodpecker drumming, Canyon Wren, Spotted Towhee. Light humming of winged insects.
QP12 1473 Canyons day birds Black-billed Magpie wind roar V2 5.0.wav	Wind roar consistent, moderately strong with active Black-billed Magpie with Green-tailed Towhee and American Robin. Bird activity close at times. Background includes Red-naped Sapsucker wood drumming, Mountain Chickadee.
QP12 1474 Canyons day birds wind roar variable V1 5.0.wav	Day bird activity with variable wind roar produces occasional leaf rustles. Bird activity windblown and muted. Present are Spotted Towhee, Canyon Wren, Mourning Dove, Western Meadowlark, Black-billed Magpie, American Robin, Dusky Grouse, Clark's Nutcracker, Chukar.
QP12 1475 Canyons day birds wind roar variable V2 5.0.wav	Wind roar with birds windblown and muted. Birds include Chukar, Dusky Grouse, prominent American Robin and Spotted Towhee with Say's Phoebe, woodpecker drumming, Western Meadowlark, Chipping Sparrow, Canyon Wren, Rock Wren. Black-billed Magpie close (3:14). Wind drone is natural.
QP12 1476 Canyons day birds wind mod consistent V1 5.0.wav	Day wind moderately consistent then building and becoming variable with birds becoming clearer. Birds include Chukar, prominent Dusky Grouse and American Robin, Spotted Towhee, hummingbird wings, woodpecker drumming, Western Meadowlark, American Robin, Chipping Sparrow, Northern Flicker, Rock Wren.
QP12 1477 Canyons day birds wind mod consistent V2 5.0.wav	Wind is consistent with bright roar and birds. Birds including Dusky Grouse, Western Meadowlark, House Wren, Black-billed Magpie, Ruby-crowned Kinglet. Traffic like drone is natural, caused by wind among rocks. Drone increases and fades with wind.
QP12 1478 Canyons day bird activity wind roar soft variable 5.0.wav	Wind is consistent roar with birds and hummingbird wings. Birds include Black-billed Magpie, Dusky Grouse, Western Meadowlark, Vesper Sparrow, House Wren, European Starling, Ruby-crowned Kinglet, American Robin. Drone is natural caused by wind among rocks.
QP12 1479 Canyons day birds wind blustery debris V1 5.0.wav	Daytime winds build slowly, sometimes blustery with windblown debris and branch rattles, then calming easily. Birds muted to moderately active during wind lulls. Birds include Lazuli Bunting, Bewick's Wren, Spotted Towhee, Nashville Warbler. Winged insects also evident during wind lulls. Rumble is caused by wind passing over rock surfaces.
QP12 1480 Canyons day birds wind blustery debris V2 5.0.wav	Wind slowly variable and sometimes blustery with windblown debris and branch rattles (voice like at times). Birds moderately active during wind lulls and include Bewick's Wren, Spotted Towhee, Lazuli Bunting, Nashville Warbler, Ash-throated Flycatcher, Black-billed Magpie. Rumble is caused by wind passing over rock surfaces.

Birds include Spotted Towhee, Lazuli Bunting, Nashville Warbler, Bewick's Wren. Rumble is caused by wind passing over rock surfaces.
QP12 1482 Canyons day birds muted wind gusty debris 5.0.wav	Wind variable, soft then quickly gusting causing debris. Birds include Say's Phoebe, Mountain Bluebird, White-throated Swift, Spotted Towhee. Winged insects apparent during wind lulls. Alluring, spacious, dry.
QP12 1483 Canyons day birds wind strong 5.0.wav	Wind strong consistent with Nashville Warbler and Spotted Towhee.
QP12 1484 Canyons day birds muted wind blustery V1 5.0.wav	Blustery wind with muted Song Sparrow and Rufous Hummingbird. Spacious and well defined. Exposed feel. Wind subsides towards end when winged insects resume flight.
QP12 1485 Canyons day birds muted wind blustery V2 5.0.wav	Day birds muted with strong blustery wind. Birds include prominent Nashville Warbler with Spotted Towhee, Ash-throated Flycatcher, Say's Phoebe.
QP12 1486 Canyons day birds Green-tailed Towhee windblown V1 5.0.wav	Green-tailed Towhee sings during blustery conditions.
QP12 1487 Canyons day birds Green-tailed Towhee windblown V2 5.0.wav	Green-tailed Towhee sings during blustery wind.
QP12 1488 Canyons day birds Green-tailed Towhee windblown V3 5.0.wav	Blustery windblown birdsong of Green-tailed Towhee.
QP12 1489 Canyons day birds wind rattling 5.0.wav	Day winds strong, gusting, roaring sometimes branch rattling (esp. 2:40, 4:20). Birds include Spotted Towhee, House Finch, Mourning Dove. Winged insects blend nicely with deep rumble caused by strong wind over rock surfaces.
QP12 1490 Canyons day birds muted wind breezy stream 5.0.wav	Wind is strong, roaring, variable with background of flowing water and birds. Birds include Violet-green Swallow, Song Sparrow, Common Yellowthroat, White-throated Swift, Bewick's Wren. Numerous winged insects.
QP12 1491 Canyons day birds muted wind wispy 5.0.wav	Day winds wispy, then easing. Bird activity subdued, muffled. Birds include European Starling, Spotted Towhee, House Wren, Western Meadowlark, Ruby-crowned Kinglet, Vesper Sparrow. Natural drone from rock walls. Wind blown debris drop-like. Deep low frequency beat is natural result of wind among rocks far away.
QP12 1492 Canyons winds calming 5.0.wav	Day winds gradually subsiding. Natural rumble from air passing over rock spaces.
QP12 1493 Canyons morning birds insects wind V1 5.0.wav	Morning birds with pronounced winged insects during light wind. Birds including Western Tanager, Mountain Chickadee, Say's Phoebe, White-throated Swift, Black-headed Grosbeak, Mourning Dove, Dusky Flycatcher, Spotted Towhee, Red-breasted Nuthatch, woodpecker drum, Northern Flicker, Canyon Wren, Chipping Sparrow, Nashville Warbler, Ruffed Grouse clear. Wind from ridge top, echoes preserved within Canyon calm.

Birds include Western Tanager, Common Raven, Mountain Chickadee, Say's Phoebe, White-throated Swift, Black-headed Grosbeak, Mourning Dove, Dusky Flycatcher, Spotted Towhee, Red-breasted Nuthatch, woodpecker drum, Northern Flicker, Canyon Wren, Chipping Sparrow, Nashville Warbler, hummingbird wings, Ruffed Grouse clear (3:33, 5:22, 7:30). Wind surges (4:41, 8:50).
QP12 1495 Canyons day birds insects wind light variable 5.0.wav	Day bird activity with pronounced insect hum, winds variable. Birds include Ovenbird, House Wren. Background with American Redstart, Ring-necked Pheasant, Chipping Sparrow, Spotted Towhee.
QP12 1496 Canyons day wind strong insects birds 5.0.wav	Day winds strong, moderately variable with numerous winged insects in flight. Winds subsiding (1:30) then insects more prominent. Cassin's Vireo later joined by Spotted Towhee. Drone caused by sound of wind within canyon walls.
QP12 1497 Canyons day birds insects wind blustery debris 5.0.wav	Day winds variable, sometimes blustery with windblown debris and branch rattles. Winged insects prominent during wind lulls. Birds moderately active during wind lulls. Includes Ash-throated Flycatcher, Nashville Warbler, Spotted Towhee, Black-billed Magpie, Lazuli Bunting, Bewick's Wren. Rumble is caused by wind passing over rock surfaces.
